



Australian Perspecta 1991

In August and September this year the Art Gallery of New South Wales will present the sixth in a series of major exhibitions dedicated to the exploration of Australia's most contemporary, challenging and innovative art.

Australian Perspecta (which alternates with the international exhibition, the *Australian Biennale*) presents an exciting and diverse selection of creative Australian talent. Curated by Victoria Lynn, Assistant Curator of Contemporary Art at the Gallery, *Perspecta 1991* includes over 200 works by more than 40 artists from across Australia.

Perspecta 1991 focuses on three-dimensional artwork. It expands our common understanding of the role of the object in art (which is often considered in conventional sculptural terms). By including other kinds of 3-D art together with a variety of recent sculpture, this year's *Perspecta* deals with questions of form, space and time in ways that are beyond the realms of traditional sculpture.
