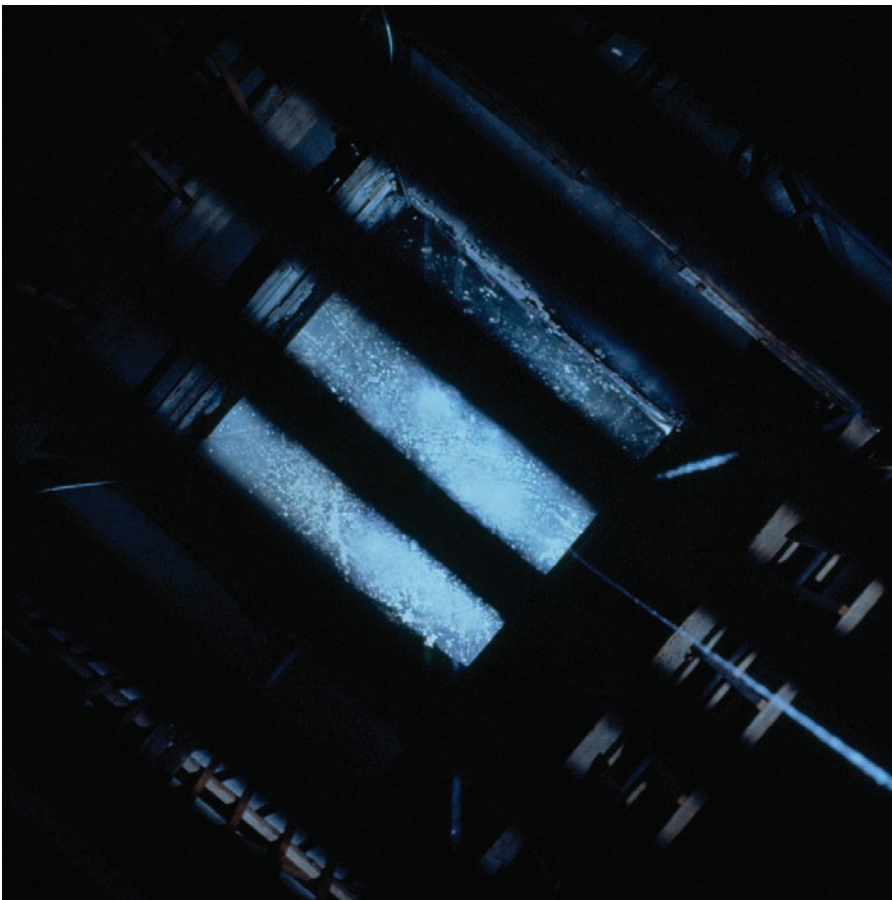


IN THE HOIST SHAFT
